

# Circle 10 Council Pilot Program for Top Unit Leaders

The Circle 10 Council has accepted an invitation by the national office of the Boy Scouts of America to participate in a program that is ultimately geared toward improving the programs that are delivered to our scouts. The goal is to have every top unit leader “Trained” by the end of 2010. This means that they have satisfactorily completed Youth Protection, This is Scouting, the appropriate indoor training and, if any applies, the appropriate outdoor training.

This program requires participation by our district professionals, volunteers at the district level as well as participation at the unit level (Pack, Crew, Team and Troop). The first task is to make sure that all the information at the district level is

accurate

Without having accurate information against which to run reports, we won't know how close we are to meeting our goal. That is the first place where the unit level participation comes. When your unit is contacted by a district level volunteer (like the Chair of the North District Training Committee), please verify the information as soon as possible - correcting anything that is not correct and adding anything that is missing. The key at this point is to make sure that the registered adult information is correct and includes:

# ALL TRAINING COMPLETED & THE DATE IT WAS COMPLETED.

With this information in place, the district level volunteers can schedule and deliver the training courses that are needed to help our unit level volunteers get the training they need prior to the end of the year. The benefits of the end result are two-fold: The North District fulfills it's obligation toward the council's goal and the programs for our youth are all reinforced with the methods of the BSA.
