ATTENTION: Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, Committee Chairs and Committee Members

Boy Scout Leader Specific training provides a hands-on application of the specialized knowledge a new leader needs to assume a leadership role in the troop. Highlights: Role of Scoutmaster, Troop Committee and ASMs, Troop Meeting and Organization, Patrol Method, Patrol Leaders' Council, Outdoor Program, Advancement, Proper Uniforming. Emphasis is on troop operation and the patrol method. *"This is Scouting"*



Step 1 and should be taken prior to Boy Scout Leader Position Specific. Boy Scout Leader Position Specific training is Step 2. Outdoor Leader Skills on October 10th and 11th is Step 3. All three courses plus Youth Protection are required for the "Trained" patch.
